1. L'histoire: quoi aborder?

- Eviter à tout pris un enseignement vertical sur l'histoire mais faire découvrir des étapes de l'histoire de la nation Australienne:
 - Exploration et découverte
 - La vie de James Cook
 - Les convicts et leur rôle dans la construction Australienne
 - La « stolen generation »
 - Le poids du Commonwealth et le lien avec le Royaume Uni
 - La monarchie en jeu en Australie

1. L'histoire: comment aborder?

Des exemples de tâches

- Imagine testimonies from settlers after a few weeks in Australia (letters to be sent home, diary entry, conversation between two people exchanging their point of views...)
- Imagine the scenario of a film / a real TV programme living the life of the 1st days of Australia
- Create a gallery of portraits of the people who made Australia for a new museum (a convict, a white settler, James Cook, an aboriginal person...)

- Imagine a new film or an autobiography on the stolen generation (create the portrait of the main characters, imagine a scene from the film, create a trailer, imagine the interview of the director...)
- Record a podcast on the stolen generation / Imagine a speech of a stolen generation child now
- Organize a TV debate : “Should Australia leave the Monarchy and become an independent Republic”?

2. La géographie et le tourisme: Comment aborder? *Des exemples de tâches*

- A trip to Australia: Write a cooperative blog about a trip to Australia / Participate in a chat about going on a trip to Australia / Organize a trip to Australia and plan your journey / Organize a debate in class about going to Australia on a school trip
- Plan a dream day in Sydney / in Melbourne
- Organize a competition: the best thing to do in Sydney / Melbourne / Queensland
- Organize a competition: the best livable city in Australia / the best livable state in Australia / the best touristy place in Australia
- Create a promotional touristy video (dub a video, create a video to promote Australia)


- Present the problems the Reef is facing and suggest solutions that could save it (imagine a video ad, organise a debate, prepare a power point presentation, create an exhibition at your school, imagine a speech to raise awareness on the issue ... etc)
- Organise an exhibition on the Australian Queensland islands : convince your friends your island is the best destination to go to / vote for the best island in the world (Magnetic island, Frazer island, Withsunday island, Hamilton island, Fitzroy island)

3. La culture: Comment aborder? *Des exemples de tâches*

- Organise an Indigenous festival at your school: prepare poster, create a radio art to inform students, organise activities, convince your friends to come and visit...
- Choose the Aboriginal tradition you prefer and present it in a video for your school website
- Imagine the trailer of a film on the Aboriginal culture
- Create a flyer for a new museum on Aboriginal culture

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- Organise Australia day at your school: prepare posters, record an opening speech for the special day, imagine activities, create an Australian meal...
 - Record an official announcement to encourage people to migrate to Australia
 - Write an article on your blog to speak about your experience of Australia as an immigrant
 - Create a radio or TV programme with testimonies of people who fulfilled the Australian dream
 - Organise an exhibition around stories of migration to Australia (invent your own)
 - Write a song / a poem about Australian culture

Des exemples de tâches

- Prepare an Australian meal (the best dish competition, organize an Aussie meal at your school for Australia day, present a typical Australian dish, present a cooking programme with a recipe you tried at home, film your parents tasting an Australian dish and add English subtitles)
- Participate in a humoristic talk show / Record a video in the style of Australian humour / Imagine the trailer of a film on Australian humour / Create a parody of “the Castle” / act a scene from “The castle”

- Apply for a job in Australia / Apply for the best job in the world competition / Tell your experience working in Australia in a blog or in a video / Imagine your dream job in Australia
- Organise a debate on First contact / Imagine a blog or a video of a contestant in the TV programme First contact / Organize an exhibition on “Aboriginal Australia today” / Imagine the scenario of a film on Aborigines today in Australia

- You have been on a school exchange for a year in Australia, post an article on your school website about your experience / Write an application letter for an exchange programme with Australia / produce a video encouraging students to come and spend a few months in an Australian school
- Choose an Australian school work on their school website, and write an article for your French school website to present your sister school in Australia

- In a podcast, choose your favourite Aussie sports and record a presentation / Imagine the interview of a famous sports player speaking of His Australian sport
- For the Commonwealth games, you produce a video presenting typical Australian sports / imagine a video presenting the importance of sports in Australia

6. Les arts: *Exemples de tâches*

- Organize an exhibition on Australian art and create audio guides
- Organize Australia day (have students create Aboriginal dot painting)
- Organize a short stories writing contest with stories occurring in Australia (in the Bush or in cities like Sydney)
- Write a song paying a tribute to Australia (Slam, rap or create a video clip from a song studied in class)


